## COFFEE FILTER WREATH

---



A fall wreath is a great way to greet your guests, but who knew it was this easy to make? You will only need a few items to knock the socks off your houseguests.

### What you'll need:

- Scissors
- Hot glue gun & hot glue sticks
- About 200 natural, unbleached coffee filters
- Styrofoam wreath form
- Fall decorations of your choice (wheat, feathers, fall leaves, pinecones, acorns, small pumpkins or gourds)
- Wire
- Small straight pins (optional)

### How It's Done:

1. Wrap wire around the foam to create a loop to hang the wreath.
2. While holding a filter at the bottom, fold in half creating a "flower." Fold the bottom of the "flower," making it flat and hot glue to your wreath form. Continue gluing from the center of the form, working your way to the outside, keeping the filters packed close together.
3. After you finish gluing all of the filters, arrange and add decorations.
4. Hang and admire!
